

STIG Viewer Release Notes – Version 3.7.0

- Updated CCI List.
- Updated Applicability Guide content as of January 2026.
- Upgraded to the latest Electron version.
- Updated application version display to reflect STIG Viewer 3.7.
- Multi-checklist workflow enhancements:
 - When selecting multiple checklist files, users are now prompted to choose whether to combine them into a single checklist tab (existing behavior) or open each checklist in its own separate tab.
 - Added support for opening multiple selected checklists in separate tabs.
- CSV import support:
 - Added support for round-trip CSV workflows, allowing users to export a STIG Viewer CSV, modify checklist data externally, and import the updated CSV back into the originating checklist.
 - Added CSV import warnings in the import preview dialog that highlight validation issues, invalid values, and potential overwrites before changes are applied.
 - Added dynamic CSV header validation that clearly identifies missing or invalid column names during import.
- Checklist and rule list improvements:
 - Added Status as a selectable option in the Rule List Display settings.
 - Added ability to sort checklist rules by STIG Status directly from the rule list.
 - Updated rule result handling so rules marked as error or informational now display the Not Reviewed status icon in the checklist.
- CKL export fixes:
 - Fixed missing <TARGET_KEY> values in exported CKL files.
 - Fixed incorrect STIG version numbers appearing when exported CKLs were reimported.
 - Restored missing STIGRef entries in CKL exports for each vulnerability.
- XCCDF import behavior updates:
 - Updated handling of XCCDF rule results so both error and informational statuses are imported as Not Reviewed.
- STIG Explorer enhancements:
 - Updated Explorer PDF hyperlink handling so external links open in the user's default browser instead of being rendered inside the application.
 - Fixed STIG Compare sort header so it appears immediately on load.
 - Resolved display issues when switching between tabs during a STIG compare.
 - Revised STIG compare order, which is now enforced to match input UUID selection order.
 - Corrected total rule count calculation after applying filters in STIG compare.
 - Added support for “Is Not” operator in STIG Compare Diff Status filter.
 - Added support for adjustable STIG compare diff modes (left, right, words, lines) via Rule List Settings.

- Filtering experience improvements:
 - Added copy/paste support for filters across checklist and Explorer tabs.
 - New filters now default to the previous filter type instead of always starting at “Content.”
- Accessibility and keyboard shortcut enhancements:
 - Added comprehensive keyboard shortcut support for common File menu actions (Open, Save, Save As, Import, Export, Save All) across Checklist and App Guide.
 - Updated File menu and keyboard shortcut behavior so Save, Save As, and related actions appear and function only when a checklist or collection is open.
 - Added ARIA key shortcut metadata to improve screen reader support and Section 508 accessibility compliance.
- User interface behavior fixes:
 - Closing the “Add STIGs” screen during STIG library progress now works when clicking outside the progress bar overlay (after the Done button appears).
 - Fixed App Guide Save As behavior so collection names update correctly after renaming.
 - Refactored the Checklist Save All workflow to ensure existing checklists are saved before Save As prompts.
 - Fixed alignment of app drop-down menus in toolbar.
 - Fixed layout and alignment issues for Rule List Display toggle buttons, ensuring consistent positioning across checklist and STIG Explorer views.
